

# CANTERBURY HIGH SCHOOL 2023-24 High School Student Dress Code

### **MINIMUM SAFE ATTIRE**

#### TOPS

- Solid color (any color)
- With Canterbury logo (can be iron-on, embroidered, etc.)
  - Purchased from Cavalier Clothing Company, BSN Sports Store, or any other store and a logo added
- Polo length must be long enough to stay tucked in (but do not have to be tucked in)
- Shirts may not show midriff, back, or lower chest
- No mesh or sheer clothing

#### BOTTOMS

- Solid or small check/ plaid in black, khaki, navy, blue, white, tan, brown, or gray
- No sweatpants or jeans (jeans only on Fridays)
- Pants can be dress, button style casual, drawstring
- When leggings are worn as pants, the accompanying top must be as long as the pinkie fingertip when hands are beside a student's legs
  - Top must also adhere to the "Tops" information above
- Shorts must be as long as the middle fingertip when hands are beside the student's legs
- Skirt length must be as long as the middle fingertip when hands are beside the student's legs

Note: tights/leggings may be worn underneath a skirt, but length requirement still applies.

#### DRESSES

- Any color
- Can be collared, sleeved dress with logo
- Spaghetti or strap dress must have a logo collared shirt underneath
- Must be as long as the middle fingertip when hands are beside the student's legs Note: tights/leggings may be worn underneath a skirt, but length requirement still applies.

#### FOOTWEAR

- Dress shoes, athletic shoes, sandals with backs
- No pool slides, flip-flops, or slippers

#### **ADDITIONAL LAYERS**

- Sweater (any color) with logo
- Canterbury logo hoodie
- Canterbury logo crew-neck sweatshirt
- Canterbury logo quarter zip

# **SPIRIT FRIDAYS**

- Students may wear jeans and Canterbury spirit wear.
  - Students may opt to wear normal school dress code pants, shorts, or skirts in lieu of jeans.
  - Jeans may be slightly distressed, but should be appropriate for school

# **DRESS-DOWN DAYS**

As announced by the High School Office.

# PROHIBITED

# The following attire is prohibited from wear during the school day:

- Denim pants, shorts, skirts, or jackets
- Cargo pants or cargo shorts
- Pants, shorts, dresses, or skirts shorter than 4" above the knee
- Yoga pants, leggings, or activewear worn as pants
- Tank tops, T-shirts, athletic tops (even when worn over collared shirts)
- Exposed undergarments
- Cropped shirts shirts must be long enough to stay tucked in for the school day
- No hats or headwear of any kind, except in the case of approved exceptions based on religious practices
- Pool slides, flip-flops, or slippers
- Any clothing with an offensive message/graphic (at the discretion of the High School office)
- Additional items as determined by the High School office, as needed.

#### NOT PERMITTED ON ANY DAYS

- Pants, shorts, dresses, or skirts shorter than the length of the middle finger when student's hands are beside legs
- No hats or headwear of any kind, except in the case of approved exceptions based on religious practices
- Cropped shirts
- Strapless or spaghetti straps
- Exposed undergarments
- Pool slides, flip-flops, or slippers
- Any clothing with an offensive message/graphic (at the discretion of the High School office)
- Additional items as determined by the High School office, as needed.
