### Athletic Recognition Ceremony

Help is needed to set up and serve ice cream.

### Canterbury Fund

Assist the Development Office during their annual giving campaign by sending follow-up emails and texts, making follow-up calls, and more. Help is needed primarily in the fall with some potential follow up in the spring.

### Carpool

During Homecoming, help with setting up, tearing down, and staffing High School sports activities, the all-school picnic, and family games.

Fun after-school events for students in Grades 5 and 6; volunteers are needed to help set up and staff each event, as well as clean up afterwards.

### Grandparent's Day

Help organize, greet, set up and clean up on this day, when grandparents are invited to attend school with their grandchildren.

### House Games

Volunteers are needed to help set up and staff this Middle School wide event, as well as clean up after the event.

### Laughing Cavalier

Volunteers are needed throughout the year to help coordinate, execute and wrap-up an elegant fundraiser which includes dinner, auctions and dancing. Help is also needed with soliciting silent auction items.

Parent volunteers will mat and hang artwork in addition to assist with set up and tear down.

Deliver AVI lunches to classrooms.

### Middle School Musical

Assist with creating costumes, making props, applying make-up, creating and tearing down the set, supervising cast party, selling tickets, and helping with dress rehearsal, the Grandparent performance, the Middle School performance, and the two public performances.

### Parent's & Special Friend's Dinner

Volunteers will set up the event, or they'll serve dinner to students and their families the evening of the event.

### Poinsettia Sales Fundraiser

Help solicit orders at various school

events, and assist in the distribution of plants in December at the Middle School.

### Pop-Up Big Dig Sales

Volunteers will help sort, fold and display items in preparation for the main events.

### School Office Assistant

Answer phones, assemble mailings and complete other projects as needed in the Division and Admissions/Development Offices.

### SCRIP Sales and Distribution

A few times a month, volunteers will contact local businesses to place SCRIP card orders, collect the orders once they're fulfilled, and deliver them to the Middle School office. Volunteers can help as frequently as they like.

### Socials

Volunteers will help chaperone after-school dances.

### Spring Book Fair

Volunteers are needed to assist with set up, sales and tear down for this all-school book fair.

### Spring Luncheon

Volunteers are needed to help with set up and tear down at this special luncheon celebrating the arts at Canterbury School.
