Tuition is more than just a number. At Canterbury, tuition allows us to:

- Attract and retain a world-class faculty and staff
- Provide a rigorous academic curriculum
- Create an environment in which each child receives individual support that helps him/her thrive and succeed with confidence
- Support dynamic programming that allows every artist, athlete, and scholar to find purpose, passion, and meaning

In addition to tuition, families are responsible for student uniform/dress, field trips, technology devices (Grades 6-12 only), purchased lunch (optional), and bus transportation (optional). Families are required to use the Canterbury FACTS Payment Plan to pay for tuition and fees. This secure online system allows families to select a payment plan that best suits their financial needs.

Financing Your Education

At Canterbury School, we seek to enroll a talented and diverse student body, and we believe the cost of an independent school education shouldn't be a deterrent.

Many options are available – including need-based financial aid and payment plans – to help families cover the cost of tuition. We even have merit-based scholarship opportunities, like the Malone Scholars Program and the Canterbury Scholar Competition. Financial aid awards may also be granted through the tax credit scholarship program.

Financial aid applications will not affect admission decisions; they are considered separately and are held in the strictest of confidence. Financial aid is awarded only to students who have completed the Admissions Application Process and have been officially accepted.
